from Mr. Hill of Calcutta on his  
return from visit to Rangoon.

RANGOON

Classification Matters Outstanding.  
List enclosed with your letter Admin/Est 26th Jan. 1959.

Barge "B.O.C. No.73"

Now on the slipway at Rangoon and  
repairs in hand,

"Cormorant"

Repairs completed and a few minor  
items remaining. Will be reported  
this month.

"Chit Myanma"

All surveys completed. Alterations  
to wiring partly completed. Mr. Kirkham  
will report this case, soonest.

Barge "B.O.C. 71"

A further plan being prepared for  
forwarding.

"Maykhalar"

Arrangements have been made to survey  
the remaining air receivers and an  
amended interim certificate recommending  
ES 4-58 and TS(OG) 4-58 will be issued.

"Pondaung"  
"Padashin"  
"Padanya"  
"Padapyan"  
"Ponnya"

A visit was made to the Owner.  
Unfortunately the gentleman in charge  
of the running of these ships was out  
of Rangoon. However, his assistant,  
indicated that these ships would not  
be retained in class. Mr. Kirkham  
had not replied to your cables and letters  
because he was unable to obtain written  
confirmation of the Owners verbal  
statement that class would not be retained.
