Dear Mr. Willis,

Ferry Boats "PADAMYA", PONDAUNG"
"PADASHIN", "PONMYA" and "PADAPYAN"

Thank you for your letter of 7th March with
enclosures.

Referring to telephone conversation this morning,
enclose, in duplicate, copy of a letter we have sent to
our agents in Burma, Messrs. Oppenheimer & Company, together
with two copies of the drawing referred to in the letter.

*It was appointed a Surveyor Board for Builders with their representatives for current
matters by Council Decree No. 100 of 1952.*
We are surprised to learn that Lloyd's Register in
London sent their comments to Rangoon on their Surveyor's
report without any consultation at all with us, especially
as we understand that our agents in Burma asked your Surveyor
to act on our behalf, and this is confirmed in Mr.
Arkam's letter to Lloyd's in London of 15th February, and
so we are being asked to pay the Surveyor's fee. We would
readily have arranged for our representatives to discuss the
whole matter in London. There also appears to have been
some delay in our receipt of the Surveyor's report after it
had arrived in this country. *Copy of report recd. London 14/2 letter sent
Sl. 26/2. It was concluded original of report sent direct Builders*

The position which has now developed is bound to
cause confusion in Burma and it is suggested that any further
comments regarding this matter which are sent either to Lloyd's
representative or to our agents, affecting both Lloyd's and
ourselves, should be discussed between the parties concerned
prior to despatch.
