EXAMINATION AS PER RULE FOR damage sustained on delivery voyage and Classification. The repairs carried out are as detailed in Rpt 10-2147 attached and are subject of damages incurred during the delivery voyage from Glasgow. All paddle floats, rudder quadrants, cabin and electrical gear, guard rails and other equipment dismantled preparatory to the delivery have been satisfactorily fitted and examined in position. The hull and machinery of this vessel were surveyed for damage and repairs recommended after her arrival at Rangoon and thereafter during the progress of repairs by Engineer Surveyor Mr. Dunne. The undersigned surveyed the vessel on completion of hull repairs before unslipping and subsequently upon completion of alterations to accommodation on Upper Deck.
