With reference to my letter of the 25th instant, I have to inform you that the report of the survey, held at Philadelphia in February/March last on account of damage stated sustained during heavy weather, has now been received at this Office.

Repairs on account of this damage were effected, but subsequently, while the vessel was being loaded, a small leakage was discovered in No.1 D.B. tank. It was recommended that shell leakage in way of No.1 D.B. tank should be examined on discharge of cargo and dealt with as found necessary.
