Steamer "PANTANASSA"

I am obliged to you for your cablegram of today's date.

From our previous correspondence you will be aware of the fact that the Special Survey which became due in June 1960 still remains to be completed by the examination of this vessel in drydock together with the ranging of the anchors and cable. The drydocking of the ship has been deferred from time to time and as the year of grace expired last June, the Committee feel that in the circumstances they can do no other than withdraw the class owing to non-compliance with the Regulations.

Instructions have therefore, today been given for a notation of "Class withdrawn" to be recorded against the ship's name in the Supplement to the Register Book and it is concluded you will inform the Owners accordingly.
