29th September last the Committee agreed to the completion
of the Special and Engine Surveys being deferred until
completion of a voyage Black Sea/Cuba and return either
Black Sea or Baltic. The case again received consideration
on the 10th January, 1962 when the Committee agreed to
maintain the class for the voyage Cuba for Black Sea ports
and thence to Piraeus for Special Survey, although they
had not previously anticipated that the voyage agreed in
September last would take so long.

proposal..... The Piraeus Surveyors are now informed by the Owners that
as no drydock is available in that area the ship will
proceed from the Black Sea to the North Continent and
arrangements will be made for drydocking either at Kiel or

June, 1961.
