STEAMER "PANTANASSA"

I am obliged to you for your memorandum of the 22nd December from which it is noted the ship was due to leave Cuba for Black Sea ports and thence proceed to Piraeus for completion of the Special Survey.

Your records will show that in September 1961 the Committee agreed to this voyage, in principle, although at that time it was not anticipated the voyage would take so long. It is concluded that in the light of your reports numbers 8869 and 8952 you consider that the vessel is in a sea-going condition until the end of next month and, on this basis, the class will be maintained for the voyage in question.
