Postponement of Special Survey until 6.61 approved 1.9.60 (GE Mtl 7.60) (the greater part of SS and ES subsequently held). On 29th June the Committee agreed to the completion of the Special Survey being deferred until the discharge of cargo from Russia, but in any case not later than the end of September, 1961 if further maintenance of class is desired.

posal

The Piraeus Surveyors now forward a copy of a letter received by them from the Owners stating the circumstances in which drydocking has so far been impossible. They state that the ship is again to load in the Black Sea and discharge in Cuba, calling at Aghios Nicolaos (Crete) en route, where they suggest that the water end of the main condenser and the sea suction valve of the general service pump be re-examined. So far as drydocking for completion of the Special Survey and dealing with other outstanding items is concerned they propose that this should be postponed until such time as drydocking is possible*. The year of grace for completion of the Special Survey expired at the end of June, 1961. *In a later cablegram requesting the issue of an LLST to complete the present charter Black Sea/Cuba and return either Black Sea or Baltic it is stated that arrangements will definitely be made for drydocking on completion.
