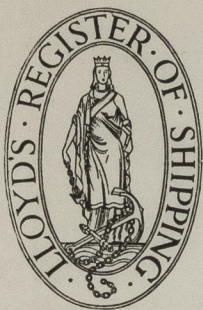

Surveyed the S.S. "PANTANASSA" 7131 tons gross of Piraeus whilst lying afloat at Piraeus on the 22nd February, 1961 & subsequently on account of Part Special Survey,

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am Recommending that she be continued as now classed with fresh record of S.S. (with date) when the survey has been completed, subject to 45 fms., of chain cable (supplied Piraeus 2,61) being verified with certificates at the earliest opportunity.

To complete the Special Survey the vessel remains to be examined in drydock, anchors and cables to be ranged & chain locker to be examined internally.
