Further to my letter of the 15th March I have to acquaint you that the Builders are complaining that they are being charged with an account for "Lloyd's Surveyor's fees in Burma".

It is concluded that this is in fact an account in respect of the services of Mr. Todd who was appointed to act on behalf of, and at the request of the Builders, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this. You will appreciate that it is not in order to charge to the Builders any fees in respect of surveys for classification.

On completion of the modifications to the feathering eccentrics of these ships, the repairs should be reported on Rpt.9 and any accounts for these surveys rendered to the Owners.

I shall be glad to receive a copy of the Surveyor's report of the 16th February issued to Messrs. Oppenheimer, which does not appear to have reached us.
