I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for Damage repairs and docking survey.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Following heavy weather and contact damage repairs have now been effected (please see Ipswich interim certificate dated 11th October, 1963):

Vessel drydocked, bottom & rudder cleaned, examined found or placed in good condition and recoated.

Shell plating (plates numbered from forward):

Starboard side: Sheer strake Nos 4&8 renewed, No.2 removed, faired and refitted and Nos 16&17 partly released, faired in place and re-riveted.

1st strake below sheer No.3 removed, faired and refitted and Nos 1&4 faired in place.

Portside: Sheer strake Nos 7&8 partly released, faired in place and re-riveted.

1st strake below sheer No.7 partly released, faired in place and

re-riveted.

In way of these plates on starboard side:

8 frames partly removed, faired and refitted and 8 faired in place, 6 deck beams partly removed, faired and refitted and 8 faired in place.

On completion repairs hose tested.

Bulwark plating starboard side:

Nos 1.2.3 & 4 plates (from forward), 1 plate at forward end of bridge housing and

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking 10-63, P.T.O. subject to indented shell plate B2 (ss) being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary next drydocking but without condition regarding fractured H plate in No.4 hold (ps) and repairs to heavy weather and contact damages.

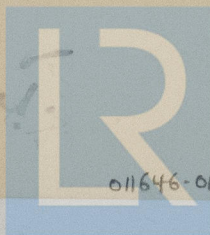

one just abaft gangway door faired in place, top bar partly renewed and one stanchion renewed.

Bulwark plating portside:

No.4 plate (from forward) faired in place, one plate at forward end of bridge housing with top bar partly renewed.

Guard rails (p&s) in way after quarter partly renewed and faired where necessary

A number of broken or cracked mooring bollards renewed. On portside in way of No.2 hatch torn deck plating locally renewed, in other positions faired in place. Also a number of fair leads renewed. On completion deck plating hose tested.

In addition to the above a number of minor damage repairs have been effected.

With a view to the damage repairs now carried out, vessel may be deleted for condition regarding heavy weather/ contact damage repairs.

For docking survey please see report (PS)

SRL 209: Indented shell plate B2 (ss) specially examined, found efficient and not dealt with now.

With regard to the 2nd item: no fractured plate in No.4 hold (ps) could be found.

Owner's Superintendent has stated that this defect was not known to the Owners and must be an error. Vessel may be deleted for this item.

App. 12: Items not dealt with now examined and found to continue efficient.
