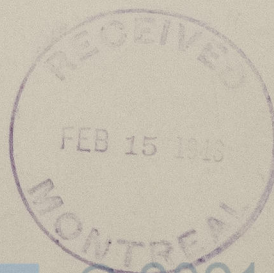
In reply to Classing Letter dated 29th. December, it is confirmed that the weather decks, bulkheads and tunnel have been hose tested as required by the Rules and the windlass and steering arrangements tried under working conditions. An echo sounding device is installed and was adjusted by specialists during the River trial.

In ships not completed before receipt of London letters of 30th. July and 12th. August, the instructions given therein have been carried out and in future reports we will insert particulars of the tween deck, bulkhead numbers, position, scantlings and also the openings therein and the method of closing.

Trusting this information will be found complete and satisfactory.

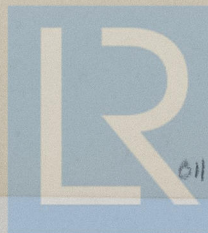
