This ship was built in 1937-8.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 5,61 and was commenced at Abo.6,61.

ACTION is DEFERRED for completion of the Special Survey by 6,62.

The class is subject to indented keel and shell plates in 'A', 'B', 'C' & 'D' strakes (p & s) (grounding damage) being examined and dealt with as necessary by completion of the Special Survey.

The Notation of "Surveys Overdue - 5,61" appears in the Register Book.

The ship has been stated to have been laid up at Oslo pending the decision regarding the Special Survey.

The Oslo Surveyors report (10,62) ship generally examined afloat to ascertain that she is structurally in a fit condition for laying up at Oslo, and report that all partsexamined generally in good condition and recommend that the class be maintained in suspense meantime, subject to all outstanding surveys being completed before the ship resumes normal sea service.

In connection with the above refer London letter to the Oslo Surveyors dated 15.10.62.

In view of the above, the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
