We write to advise you that it has been decided to withdraw the above vessel from Classification, and we shall, therefore, require the cancellation of the Load Line Certificate.

The vessel will be stopped at our Leamouth Wharf for annual overhaul this weekend, and following a slipping and shell inspection she will continue to trade within smooth water limits, i.e. pumping cargoes on the Solent Banks, and discharging only at berths contained within the limits of Hurst Castle to the West and the Forts, off Portsmouth, to the East. This follows the arrangements applied to our "Sand Runner" when last April she was restricted to trading within the limits as set out above.

We look forward to your advices in due course.
