This aluminium launch was built by Messrs. J. & K. Smit's Aluminium verwerkende Industrie N.V. Krimpen a.d. Lek in 1958 and is classed with Bureau Veritas.

The Owners desire classification with this Society also.

The plans have been examined, the scantlings found satisfactory, and the launch examined internally and externally and found in good condition, therefore on receipt of a F.E. Rps, the launch can be recommended to the Committee for the class A Hydrofoil Craft for service on the Dutch and Belgian coasts north of Ostend.

The Rot. Surveyors in a F.E. Report (3,60) launch examined, scantlings and arrangements verified with approved plans and materials and workmanship satisfactory.

The equipment of anchor and perlon rope cable on board is considered suitable for the service of the launch and also for figure 1 without Notation L.ACP.

IT IS THEREFORE SUBMITTED the launch is eligible to be classed Al Hydrofoil Craft for service on the Dutch and Belgian coasts north of Ostend, with Notation SS 3,60 and record of DS 12,59 with descriptive Notation: Aluminium alloy hydrofoil launch.


