On the 2nd February last Mr.Chisholm was informed, in view of the fact that this type of anchor has been used in so many German ships, the Committee would not object to its being supplied to the above vessel and the two sister ships now building, if the Owners of these vessels specially desired to adopt it and would make a request to that effect.

Since that date a further letter has been forwarded to Mr.Chisholm informing him that this type of anchor, with certain amendments, will be recommended to the Committee for approval in vessels classed, or intended for classification, with the Society, when a model of the anchor, as amended, has been received.

No request has been received from the Owners regarding the supplying of this type of anchor to the above vessel, but in view of the letter recently forwarded to Mr.Chisholm it is submitted the anchors now supplied might be accepted.
