This is to Certify that I have surveyed the s.s. "BEECH HILL" 7150 gross tons of LONDON, on the 30th May 1964 and subsequently whilst she lay afloat at Rangoon for General Examination for postponement of Special Survey, Condition of class items and Renewal of Load Line,

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as classed subject to rivets in Fr.148 Plate F15 (Stb'd No.1 L/H); hole in bottom in way of No.1 stb'd bilge striking plate; leak from P & S Fuel Oil Deep tanks being specially examined and dealt with at the Special Survey and also subject to outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended and that Special Survey be postponed till end AUGUST 1964.
