S.S. "BEECH HILL"

With reference to our letter of the 4th instant when we informed you that the General Examination and Load Line Certificate of this vessel for two months extension of the outstanding Special Survey had been completed at Rangoon. We have today received a letter from the Master dated 6th June, which gives the following information.

"I have today received a short term Load Line Certificate which has been issued until the end of July. As I do not think the vessel will complete loading before the 16/17th instant, she will not be able to sail before the 24th instant as the tides are not suitable before that date, so weather permitting, she should arrive at her first discharge port about the 25th July, then she has to go to Constanza to discharge about 6000 tons, unless the discharge is very quick, I cannot see the vessel being completely discharged by the end of July".

In view of the above information, it would appear that we would be faced with the necessity of applying for a further extension of this Load Line Certificate to take the vessel to the Survey port, but as the vessel is not likely to leave the port of Rangoon where the recent Survey has been held before the 24th June, would it not be possible for the two months extension granted in your letter of the 8th May last, to commence from a date nearer to the sailing date instead of 19 days before, which is the date shown on the recent short term certificate issued at Rangoon.


