I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 12th instant, and note that these vessels have been re-commissioned, and are expected to leave Syra on or about the 25th instant.

In the case of the "OAK HILL" the Main Boiler Survey, which became due so long ago as November, 1962, has been partly held, but it is concluded the Survey will be completely re-held before the vessel leaves Syra. As regards the "ELM HILL" the Main Boiler Survey became due last March, and it is concluded this Survey will also be held now.
