Steamer "BEECH HILL"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of today's date and in confirmation of my telephonic reply this afternoon am pleased to inform you that the Committee will be prepared to grant the year of grace for the Special Survey in this instance until May 1964 provided the requirements of a General Examination of hull and machinery receive satisfactory attention before the vessel is recommissioned. During the trial of the main engines attention should be paid to the flow of the discharge sea water to ensure that the sea valves (suctions) are sufficiently clear of sea growth.

The main Boiler Survey should be held at the same time.

In view of the fact that the vessel was last drydocked in November 1962 it is concluded she will again be drydocked about November next. I shall be obliged if you will kindly ask your Local Agents to request the attendance of a Surveyor when required.
