Motorship "PACIFIC WIND"

Before your report No. 10607 receives the consideration of the Committee, I would refer you to Vancouver report No. 9336 and shall be glad to learn whether any action was taken by you concerning the Metalock repairs to No. 1 cylinder of the starboard forward auxiliary engine and the bedplate of the starboard after auxiliary engine.

Concerning the hull, I would point out that for reclassification it will be necessary for the following to be done:-

1. The requirements of a Special Survey (D) to be complied with, including the drilling of the shell plating amidships and in the vicinity of the peaks, the strength deck amidships and in such parts of the structure where signs of wastage are evident.
2. Any major repairs which have been or are to be effected to the structure since the ship was disclassed to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship and confirm that the materials used are in accordance with the Rules.
3. Structural alterations which may have been carried out since the ship was disclassed to be specially examined in order to ascertain the character of the workmanship and confirm that the materials used are in accordance with the Rules.
4. Structural alterations affecting the longitudinal and/or transverse strength of the ship which may be required at this time should be carried out in accordance with plans approved, and

5. Full particulars of the equipment on board (which should be found or placed in accordance with Rule requirements) including weights and tests of anchors also length, diameter and tests etc. of chain cable to be furnished.

In future similar cases application should be made in writing for reclassification prior to the surveys being commenced. In this respect I would refer you to Section 15, Paragraph 1501, of the Rules.
