Your classing letter of the 3rd instant to hand with reference to the above named vessel, Report #4830, I wish to state that a spare power driven lubricating oil pump is fitted. One of the auxiliary engines can be started by hand for first charging up the air receivers. The donkey boiler can be used for heating the Boiler fuel and steam coils in main cargo tanks having a 1" dia. steam coil to boiler fuel bunker with return to hotwell and 1½" and 2" steam coils to main cargo tanks. The boiler is also used for domestic heating purposes.
