Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines  
in

## Removal of D.E.M.S. Accommodation.

The D.E.M.S Accommodation within the bridge space in way of the No.5 hatchway  
has now been removed.

4 side scuttles (p.s.) and 6 (s.s.) have been removed and the apertures blanked  
off by means of riveted and welded circular steel plates.

The overboard scuppers discharging from wash place and W.C., port and starboard  
sides of the tonnage well have also been closed by welded plates.

The aperture in the after W.T. Bulkhead of the tonnage well, previously closed  
by an E.W. steel plate, remains intact.

The companion previously erected on the closing plate of the tonnage opening to  
give access to the accommodation, has now been removed and the aperture permanently  
closed by means of an E.W. steel plate.
