Dear Sir,

With reference to our First Entry Report No.59450, submitted today in respect of the above vessel, we beg to inform you that this barge has now been delivered to the Owners, Messrs. Fielder, Hickman & Co., Ltd., for service on the River Thames.

The equipment supplied to the barge, in accordance with the instructions of the Owners' Representative, is one bower anchor, weighing 1 cwt. 2 qr. 4 lb., and 30 fathoms of 5/8" short link chain cable, all tested to the Society's requirements.

This equipment has never been submitted for the Committee's approval, as was requested on the approved construction plan, but if considered acceptable the notation Lloyd's A & Cr could be assigned.
