Rockbreaker Pontoon "TOKANUI"

In reply to your letter of the 7th instant, I would inform you that no further examination of the boiler is considered to be necessary unless salt water has entered the boiler internally.

So far as the electrical equipment is concerned, the plan forwarded with my letter of the 2nd June has been approved. Attention was drawn to the omission of electric navigation lights and the use of Pyrotenax cable owing to departure from the specification thereby involved. These departures do not affect classification, and as it is noted from your letter these were authorised by the Owners, the matter is now considered to be in order.

I am very glad to learn from your cablegram of the 20th instant that the plans have now reached you.
