With reference to Glasgow Report No. 53836 on David Rowan & Co's Engine & Boiler No. 956, I have to acquaint you that the First Entry Reports have come to hand from the Leith Surveyors intimating that this machinery and boiler have been fitted on board the steamer "FRANCIS FLADGATE", and I may say that this vessel has today been classed #100A1, subject to permanent repairs to the shell plating on the port side in way of No.2 hold being carried out at the Owners' convenience. Notations have also been assigned of Cargo battens not fitted, Lloyd's A & C P, #LMC 10,33, CL, Electric Light, machinery aft.

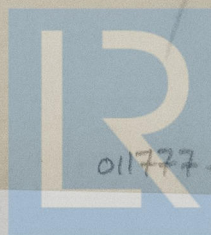
