

EXTRACT FROM GOTHENBURG CLASSING LETTER DATED 30th Sept.1960.

26050"ROSPIGGEN" - This ship has today been classed #100A1 "For service between harbours in the Stockholm, Archipelago and the Aland Islands" together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

You should forward a General Arrangement plan if available as there does not appear to be a Capacity Plan, and furthermore you should confirm that the steel used was manufactured at works recognised by the Committee and tested in accordance with the Rules as this has been omitted from your report.

It is concluded that the breaking test for the chain cable was 27630 Kgs. per Rule and not 25665 Kgs. as reported.

It is concluded that an automatic voltage regulator is fitted in connection with the main engine driven generator, but your confirmation is desired.
