"GAIA". This steamer is at present due at Leghorn, but is likely to remain trading in the Mediterranean for <sup>c/</sup>account of the Italian Authorities. We have recently cabled Messrs Gastaldi & Co., at Leghorn, our Agents, suggesting this vessel be drydocked as there are certain other repairs to be effected, and perhaps in this case it would be advisable for you to communicate with your Surveyor, so that a further examination can be effected whilst she is in that port.
