With reference to the steamers "PENICHE",
"AMARANTE", "S. VICENTE" and "GAIA" which as a war
emergency measure have been examined by the Society's
Surveyors and assigned a record of "G.L" with date of
survey, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of
this Society consider that as in the case of classed
vessels which are overdue for Special Survey the above
mentioned steamers should be submitted for examination
by the Society's Surveyors at intervals of six months
in order that a fresh date of survey may be made in the
Register Book and that the boilers should be surveyed
annually.

I shall, therefore, be obliged if you will kindly
let me know, for the information of the Committee, what
steps you propose taking in the matter.
