Reverting to my letter of the 28th February 1955 and subsequent correspondence regarding ships of the United States Government Reserve Fleet, these cases have now again been reviewed by the Committee who feel that the time has arrived when a notation of "Class Suspended" should be added to the existing notation of "Laid up - Surveys overdue" which appears in the Register Book in each instance.

I forward herewith a list of the ships in which this action is being taken, and leave to your discretion the question as to which interested parties you advise.

You will appreciate that this action hardly alters the present position in that the class will continue to appear in the Register Book and should the vessels subsequently come under the control of private enterprises it will be necessary only for a Special Survey to be held for maintenance of class without qualification.
