M.S. "MAXSTAR"

I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know what arrangements they propose making for this vessel to be examined in dry dock, as it would appear from the records in this Office that she has not been seen in dry dock by the Society's Surveyors since September, 1952.

S.S. "THROCKLETOR" (N.N. MOZART)

I have to acquaint you that this vessel has recently been purchased by the Cia. Comercial Transatlantica S.A. who have changed her name to "Mozart". The new Owners' Agents are Messrs. Spiros Polemis Sons Ltd. of 11, Broadway, New York, 4, and in the circumstances, I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed to be made for the Screwshaft Survey, which became due at the end of December last, to be carried out.

At the same time I have to point out that as this vessel has not been seen in dry dock by the Society's Surveyors since August, 1952, arrangements should be made for a further examination in dry dock to take place at an early date.

With reference to your memorandum of the 25th June 1952, it is concluded that this vessel is still laid up, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.
