Donkey Boiler

Dear Mr. Rodger:

I have your letter of the 9th June, and as you have tested the Donkey Boiler to 220 lbs. and magnafluxed the fusion welded girth seams with satisfactory results, in my opinion, you will be justified in accepting the boiler in the circumstances of the case, for a working pressure of 110 lbs. per sq. inch.

When making your report, you had better explain the circumstances, stating that the boiler was made by the Boston Navy Yard, who were not familiar with civilian requirements for fusion welded boilers and inadvertently overlooked the same.

The test results and letter from U.S.A. are returned herewith and should be appended to your report.
