CONSTRUCTED BY BOSTON NAVY YARD WITH ELECTRIC
WELDED CIRCUMFERENTIAL SEAM WITHOUT TEST PLATES
OR STRESS RELIEF OR XRAYING STOP INFORM OFFICER
IN CHARGE THAT IF VESSEL IS TO BE AMERICAN FLAG
U S GOVERNMENT RULES WILL LIMIT WORKING PRESSURE TO
THIRTY POUNDS STOP AMERICAN BUREAU RULES SAME STOP
IF VESSEL FOREIGN FLAG LLOYDS RULES WILL PERMIT
FIFTY POUNDS BUT DOUBT IF THIS SUFFICIENT FOR
OWNERS REQUIREMENTS STOP PLEASE ADVISE WHAT WILL BE
DONE IN MATTER"
