

Dear Sir:

I think it well to inform you that the Owners have drawn attention to the date of build appearing on the Classification Certificates issued for the Motor Vessel "WILLIAM C. McTARNAHAN", which is given as September 1941. This would appear to have been taken from the last date given in the report on the electrical equipment which is shown as the 18th September, 1941.

The Owners state that the vessel actually went into commission on July 28, 1941, which has been confirmed by the Mobile Surveyors. In the circumstances, it has been thought well to amend the certificates accordingly, and you might be good enough to note this correction for your records.
