Replying to your letter of the 10th December regarding the Special Survey of this ship, I have to acquaint you that, in view of her age, the Committee will require a comprehensive General Examination to be carried out in dry dock before any deferment of the inspection can be considered, and the period of postponement will be determined by the condition of the vessel as found at this examination.

A General Examination should be carried out as soon as possible, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you propose making in the matter.

There are no conditions of class against the ship, but I take this opportunity to remind you that the boilers will become due for survey in March next.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Society's local Surveyor, and he will be pleased to furnish you with any information you require regarding the nature of the General Examination and Special Survey.
