I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for General Examination for postponement of Special Survey (D) due June, 1964 until June, 1965 and Wear & Tear Repairs, Docking and Damage Survey.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Wear & Tear Repairs now done:

Rivets in bottom strakes of Fore Peak tank, found wasted and scrubbed due to action of chain cables, now pad welded.

Chain locker: Deck head, found torn in way of spurling pipes, doubled 1 metre square round each pipe and bottom of each pipe doubled 0.5 m. high

Aft Peak: Bulkhead with transom space doubled at top strake across width of tank.

No.1 Hold: Knee brackets at base of forward longitudinal bulkhead renewed. Base of bulkhead between Nos.1 & 2 Holds, found wasted, now cropped and insert fitted 40 cm. high across width of hold.

No.2 Hold: 5 fractured bilge brackets welded and fitted with doublers. Knee brackets at base of forward longitudinal bulkhead renewed.

No.2 Tween Deck: Forward starboard deck head pillar, found buckled, removed, faired and refitted.

Air pipe for No.2 DB tank, stbd side, part renewed.

No.4 Tween Deck: Wasted deck at port Centre and stbd. of aft bulkhead cropped and inserts fitted.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with ~~without~~ fresh record of dry docking 4,64, subject to any outstanding condition of Class being attended to as previously recommended.

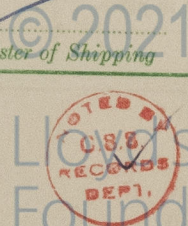

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No.5 Tween deck: Forward port deck head pillar, found buckled, removed faired and refitted.

The two life boats fitted on the bridge boat deck, being superfluous to requirements, have now been removed and guardrails fitted.

The provision of Circular No.1959 regarding General Examination of ships over 14 years ~~old~~ having been fully complied with and the ship found or placed in satisfactory condition, it is submitted that the Owner's request for postponement of the Special Survey until June, 1965 merits the favourable consideration of the Committee.

Damage:

Alleged sustained by contact with SS "HENRIETTA LATSI" in strong winds at Kynossoura on the 18th April, 1964.  
Starboard navigation light, housing and overshadowing strip, all crushed and broken, now renewed.
