
We have just contracted to purchase the above vessel, delivery of which will be given to us next month.

We understood from the present Owners that vessel passed Special Survey in July, 1951, when the Survey was completed. On seeing the ship's records in your Office a few days ago, however, we ascertained that although Machinery and Hull Surveys are dated July, 1951, the Boiler Survey is dated May, 1951. We understood from one of your Officials that that was the date the Boilers were opened and usually you give that date and not the date of completion of the Survey.

Our system, for all our vessels, is to have all the surveys of each vessel expiring simultaneously, as otherwise there is a certain amount of inconvenience in having an Annual Boiler Survey on a different date to the Load Line, and also, on expiry of the Class the Boilers finishing a bit earlier than the Machinery Survey.

We shall be extremely obliged if you will request your Committee to see their way clear in amending the Boiler Survey of this vessel so that it is also dated July, 1951, to coincide with the Machinery and Hull Surveys. We found in the past that these different dates can cause us a lot of nuisance, and that is why, in all our vessels, we have them expiring simultaneously.

Your kind attention to this matter will be greatly appreciated.
