Delivery Voyage Liverpool Area to Piraeus

1. With reference to the telephone conversation Beckwith/Jamieson.
2. On basis of limited stability information supplied and comparison with similar vessels undergoing similar delivery voyage the stability should be satisfactory provided.
  - 2.1 Cunnings of Access Doors to Engine Room and Accommodation are raised to 30 inches and a total of 20 tons of solid ballast is arranged as low in Engine Room as possible and distributed fore and aft to suit trim.
  - 2.2 In association with proposed consumables of Oil Fuel in bunkers 25 tons in service tanks 2 tons fresh water 3 tons crew stores and effects 3 tons this will give mean draft over marks of about 9ft 11 inches.
3. Fee for this investigation will be £200, a further communication will follow.
