The Liverpool Surveyors report a complete Special Survey in dry dock in accordance with the Rules, and confirm that the requirements of I.C.D. for a voyage Liverpool to Piraeus have been dealt with.

The Surveyors recommend the vessel be reinstated in class as a Cargo Ship, and it is considered this is in error.

They also recommend repairs to the Rudder Head Bush, to be dealt with on arrival of tug in Greece.

It is submitted that the tug be reinstated in Class as built:-
