Dear Sir,

The Special Survey on the tug "FLYING COCK" is due this month. The Owners would like to defer this Survey until the end of this year. I have told them that subject to a satisfactory General Examination in the near future, I have no doubt that our Classification Committee will favourably consider their application.

You will see that the vessel was seen in drydock in September last.

The Owners would like also to defer the Special Survey on the tug "PEA COCK", which was due last month. According to their present arrangements for the ship she will be docked again in October or November next, when she could be put through Special Survey. In the circumstances they would like to submit the vessel to a General Examination at the present time for deferment of the Special Survey until some time before the end of the year of grace. I have told them that if this Examination is found satisfactory no doubt the Classification Committee will agree.
