attend upon the Steel Steam Tanker "MORILLUBE" of New
York, 10222 Gross Registered Tons, for the purpose of making
an examination of the condition of the vessel as she lay afloat
in Sydney Harbour after having been damaged by enemy action on
the 18th January, 1943, shortly after leaving Sydney, N.S.W.
in ballast, on a voyage to a United States port.

The decks, shell plating as far as practicable, rudder, pump
rooms, peaks, machinery spaces, accommodation spaces, furniture
and fittings and general outfit examined and found in good
condition with the exception of the damaged portions which are
detailed in a separate report.

The bottom of the vessel was not examined in dry dock, the oil
tanks were not examined internally and the chain cables were not
examined at this time.
