The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

SRL 231:

Indented bottom shell plates B-2 and 3; C-3 and 4 (s.s.f.) B-3 and 4; C-4 (p.s.f.)

Now permanently repaired:

B-2 (s) renewed; B-3 (s) removed, faired and refitted; C-4 (s) renewed.

B-3 (p) should be B-2 (p), part renewed, remainder faired in place.

B-4 (p) , should be B-3 (p), renewed; C-4 (p) renewed. Structure internally intact.

Item may now be deleted.
