In reply to your classing letter of the 1st February, we have to state that -

The scantlings of frames from 1/2 L forward to 15% of length from stem are 7" x 3" x .36" B.A with 9" x 3 1/2" x .40 B.A. in way of dry cargo hold.

The foundation plate on floors is 36" x .40 and the scantlings of the centre girder bottom angles are 4 x 4 x 48 dle. angles.

With regard to position of propane bottles in centre cargo tanks these are placed in Nos. 1, 2, 5, 6, 7 & 8 tanks counting from forward.

The positions given were counted from aft as the tanks were previously numbered from aft.
