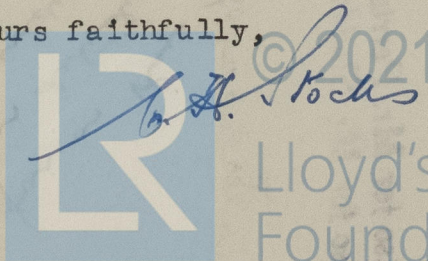
S.S. "ST.ARVANS", S.S. "ST.HELENA",

I duly received your letter of the 28th. Sept. respecting the proposed classification of the above vessels, contents of which were advised to Mr. Church, Principal Superintendent, South American Saint Line Ltd., who now replies as per copy of letter attached.

It will be noted that Mr. Church enquires why the procedure suggested for the "ST.HELENA" (built 1944, S.S. May 1948) cannot be adopted for the "ST.ELWYN" (built 1940, S.S. June 1948). In my opinion the small difference in age, namely 4 years, should not be a hindrance to similar treatment for class - except for the provision of plans.
