Dear Sir,

I enclose enquiry received from Mr. Church, Principal Superintendent for the South American Saint Line regarding the 4 vessels they have classed with British Corporation.

I advised Mr. Church that we probably held plans of sister vessels of the "ST.ARVANS" and "ST.HELENA" but would wish to examine the plans of the "ST.MARGARET" and "ST.ELWYN".

In the case of the "ST.ARVANS" the full requirements for Special Survey would apply but the Committee might agree to modified Special Surveys in the case of the other 3 vessels, the extent being largely determined by the condition found on examination.

I submit these concessions for favourable consideration.

I should add that Mr. Church is not disposed to accept "Class Contemplated" and yearly certificates until the next Special Surveys fall due; the alternative to these proposals therefore is that he retains B.C. class until the next Special Surveys fall due.

An early reply would be appreciated.
