on 22nd June, 1956, and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~:-

Side bunker after hatchway coamings (p. & s) removed and two 20" diameter flush deck scuttles fitted, *with bayonet joint covers & chain attachments.*

After peak store hatchway removed and one 24" diameter ^{flush} scuttle fitted, *cover has chain attachment.*

Main bunker hatchways on boiler casing renewed and new size of openings are 5'-6" x 5'-6" with a 6" coaming and situated on boiler casing 2'-6" above deckline. ✓
