## CLASSING LETTER

29344 "MAGNOLIA" - As recommended, class having been continued subject only to the screwshaft cone being specially examined at the next Screwshaft Survey as previously recorded. I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 24th September, the contents of which have been noted.

"HULL CITY" - As recommended. The Rule chain cable for the equipment letter "y" is 165 fathoms of 1.5/16" diameter. Two lengths of chain cable now supplied appear from tests and weight to be 1.5/16". It is concluded therefore that you are in error in reporting Rule and length of chain cable on board as 150 fathoms and Rule diameter as 1 1/4", but your confirmation is desired.


The condenser water box was renewed at Bergen in June last, when it was found to be fractured and as it is not understood why it should again be renewed, your comments are desired.
