Vosper Ltd, Portsmouth, attend on board the Trawler "BIRCH" 452 tons gross of London, for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage stated to have been sustained through being struck by the Tug "INDUSTRIOUS", 84 tons gross of Portsmouth, on the 31st March, 1948, while lying moored at the Camber Quay, Portsmouth.

On the 22nd November, 1948, and subsequent dates, the vessel then lying moored at the Camber Quay, Portsmouth, the Undersigned upon making examination

FOUND

Starboard side: No. 2 shell plate in 1st strake below poop sheer, set in and indented.

Nos. 1 and 2 cant frames in way buckled.

Two beam knees and two tank top brackets buckled.

RECOMMENDED

That plate be cropped and part renewed.

That No. 1 cant frame be cropped, removed, faired and refitted and that No. 2 cant frame be faired in place.

That beam knees and brackets be removed, faired and refitted.

Further recommended that all fittings removed to execute or facilitate the above repairs be replaced as before, that all new and disturbed work be recoated and that the whole of the work be carried out in such a manner as to place this part of the vessel in the same good and efficient condition as obtained before the alleged damage was sustained.
