M.T. "MAGNOLIA" - Works poor Engine TAMS 396

Dear Sir,

We refer to the Works poor Diesel Engine installed in the above ship in 1951.

This engine was built under Lloyd's survey and test at the makers works in Amsterdam and delivered to Portsmouth in 1950.

In order that engine could be started up at stated intervals and kept in a good state of preservation it was decided to instal in the above hull pending completion and sale.

This work, as well as shaft and thrust alignment was carried out by Messrs. Vosper at Portsmouth under the supervision of your surveyors when it was run in the ship.

From 1951 to this date the engine has received a satisfactory degree of care and maintainance including starting and running about once every three weeks.

It has not, however, run in service or under load except during makers acceptance tests.

We would like to suggest that to bring the machinery date in to synchronisation with the Ship Special survey date that a token inspection might be carried out at this stage.

The Engine and auxiliaries will be tested under full power conditions on acceptance early in the new year.

We should be glad to know as soon as possible if this meets with your requirements.
