~~Enclosed~~ Enclosed please find the machinery and Electrical 1st Entry Reports for the Trawler "BIRCH", which has been towed to Hull for completion. Hull Surveyors advised.

The delay in forwarding these reports is very greatly regretted, but Mr. Rogers states he has had difficulty in getting certain particulars from Messrs. Vosper Ltd.

It is submitted that the total fees be charged at Hull and 75% of the machinery installation fee (total fee £32.) and 50% of the electrical fee (total fee £24.0.0.) be credited to this Office, plus travelling expenses, as stated on the reports.

No survey has been carried out on the hull since vessel was reported in March, 1951, as per Southampton Report No. 20616 dated 28.3.51, and it is submitted, as stated in that report, that a full Special Survey should be carried out at Hull and a Special Survey fee charged. The Hull Surveyors were advised about this on the 28th September, 1954.

If our proposal for the machinery and electrical fees, meets with your approval, we shall be obliged if you will kindly inform the Hull Surveyors accordingly.
